## Grants

Teachers whose students have entered work in the Guild's current American Indian Student Art Show are eligible to apply for [grants](#) to purchase equipment, materials and/or supplies for their school's art program. Written applications are required. Grants vary in amount and are limited to one grant per school per year. The current pool of funds available is \$10,000. Since its inception in 1992 over \$100,000 has been awarded to teachers.

## General Information

The application must be postmarked by **September 5, 2016**. Please remember to include your \$25 application fee.

Applications postmarked between September 6 and September 16 must be accompanied by a \$75 late fee per applicant, in addition to the \$25 fee. Any applications postmarked after September 16 will not be accepted. Hand-delivered or online applications must meet the same deadlines. The Heard Museum Guild is not responsible for lost mail or slow delivery.

Payments may be made by cashier's check, money orders, or on-line credit card charge.

We use a blind jurying process to rate artists for entrance to our market. Be sure you are sending the finest pictures available of your art. Images are required from artists who did not submit new images for the 2015 or the 2016 Fair. The better the quality of pictures, the easier for the judges to jury your art for a higher score.

Contracts will be mailed to accepted artists in October with further information about the Fair, including booth fee due dates and guidelines for entering Juried Competition.

Artists 17 years old and under whose relatives have been accepted into the Fair may sell their work in their relatives' booth and enter Juried Competition. Each youth artist must submit their own application. Please see the application for information on how to obtain one. There are no fees for a youth artist, but a copy of a proof of tribal enrollment is required.
