Graduation Predictions

- Out of 44 Standard Pathway students, 5 will not graduate.
- These 5 are missing credits beyond their current enrollment.
 - 2 could graduate over the summer
 - 2 could graduate after fall semester 2017
 - 1 could graduate after spring semester 2018
- 42 out of 43 students will require ADC in order to graduate.

Graduation Concerns

- There are 6 students that need to make up seat time due to excessive absences
- There are 5 students that have to pass their Dual Credit/Honors/AP courses in order to graduate.
- There are 8 students that must pass their credit recovery courses in Edgenuity in order to graduate.
- There are 4 students at risk of not graduating if they do not pass their current classes.

Interventions

- After-school program for tutoring, credit recovery, and attendance make-ups
- Receive a graduation status and attendance letter at home
- Graduation Checks have been performed throughout the school year
- Review of graduation progress by the School Improvement Team
- Individual meetings with administration and counselors
- Graduation audit was completed for each senior
- Saturday School at Newcomb High School for attendance

Successes

- 40 out 47 of our seniors have been accepted to at least one 4 year university.
- 100% of our eligible seniors have applied to at least one 4 year university.
- 100% of our students have taken the ACT.
- 8 students have been awarded scholarships totaling \$43,993.55.
- 1 student may be eligible for Chief Manuelito
- Our highest score on the ACT was a 21.
- Our students have been accepted to 30 different institutions from Hawaii to West Virginia and Florida.
